History at Horndon on the Hill Church of England Primary is designed to promote learning and personal growth for all our pupils, regardless of their starting point, ability or specific need. We want to provide opportunities for children to grow into positive, responsible citizens by developing their skills and knowledge, whilst working and cooperating with others ensuring all our pupils are inspired for future learning and employment.

Intent:

- Develop a secure understanding of the chronology of the British Isles and other important periods/locations of history.
- To discover links and connections between the history they learn and the wider community and locality.
- Draw on similarities and differences within given time frames and across previously taught history.

Implement:

- History based topics from Cornerstones Maestro in all year groups, which ensures full coverage and progress of skills and knowledge.
- Cross curricular outcomes in history are specifically planned for, with especially strong links between history and English identified, planned for, and utilised.
- Enhance knowledge and understanding of history through educational visits and fully utilising the local area to understand history in the context of real life.

Impact:

- Clear progression of skills across Key Stage One and Key Stage Two that builds on prior knowledge that can be demonstrated in their books and through discussions with the children.
- Children will become increasingly aware of how historical events have shaped the world that they currently live in.
- Children are able to retain prior learning and explicitly make connections between what they have previously learned and their current learning.
