### Awards - We received two awards this week:



You have successfully added new art forms which have enhanced learning. The school have used Music 4 Change, local visual artists and potters to kickstart various topics. Some of the bonuses of arts rich learning arise from the connections made

with external partners, not all of which need be arts related. One such example is your school newspaper, where the children research, interview, take photographs, edit and then publish a weekly newspaper about events in the school, many of which are arts related. This has led to a local newspaper editor offering help and insights for the children. This real-world learning and sense of purpose seems to have been highly motivating to children and is an example of how engaging in the arts leads to tangible outcomes.'

We are delighted to have been awarded our Gold Standard Excellent Level Travel Award-May 2023l. This has been due to the hard work, perseverance and dedication of the JRSOs (Junior Road Safety Officers), all staff, pupils and the wider local community. We recently held 10 days of active travel running over 2 school weeks. The children devised and promoted active ways of travel. We have installed a cycle/scooter shelter. The school





has taken part in a large active travel campaign which ran in 2022 and 2023. As an incentive for taking part, our LA were offering to provide a new scooter pod to the school that won the bid, which we won.

### **Mathletics**



Our year 5 mathematicians (genius level!) entered a Mathletics competition. This was a Thurrock wide event involving competitors from 20 schools. Our children were amazing!! They worked together as a team, cooperated and solved some fiendishly tricky maths problems - coming 4<sup>th</sup> overall. Amazing effort year 5!

**SATs** 

We were totally amazed but not surprised at how well year 6 worked, behaved and endeavoured during their SATs this week. The SATs are a snapshot measure that are statutory, and we want to acknowledge how difficult we thought the papers were this year. The children were undaunted throughout, and gave it 100% which is a testament to yourselves and the whole Horndon School Community. Year 6, you are all winners!



Pupils transfer from secondary schools to post-16 settings or placements at the end of year 11, in the September after their 16th birthday.

FOCUS GROUP 13 Phase Transition: EYFS to Primary School

### Let's share ......

Transitions should be seen as a process not an event, and should be planned for and discussed with children and parents. Settings should communicate information which will secure continuity of experience for the child between settings.

Transition is a time of change and can be a source of both excitement and anxiety for children and for parents. Throughout the transition process, young children need to feel secure and confident that their needs, wants, likes and dislikes will be understood.

Planning and preparation for transition may involve a range of different elements, though

these are not necessarily separate activities. They are likely to include:

- establishing relationships
- · sharing information
- visit
- · preparation in the setting
- · training and support settling in and follow up
- · creating continuities




