Primary School Applications

The application window for next September's primary school intake will be open from Wednesday 1st November 2023. The strict deadline for parents to make an application is Monday 15th January 2024. This crucial deadline applies to parents and carers of children who were born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020.



There will be a Parent Information Briefing on Thursday 26th October to help parents/carers through the school admissions application process for Reception 2024 intake. The sessions will include a presentation breaking down all the key areas of the admissions process, and there will also be an opportunity for you to ask our admissions staff any questions you may have about how the process works.


