SEN - Preparing for Adulthood (PFA) Team

The main responsibility and focus of the team

- providing advice and guidance around the key areas of Preparing for Adulthood
- attend and provide support at EHCP Annual Review meetings, amending as required
- provide information, advice, and guidance ahead of and during the educational transition

Roles and responsibilities within the team

- case management writing EHCPs and attending annual review meetings from year 12 (and where required, from year 9), supporting phase transitions and the 'mover-in or out' processes, attending CPP & CIN meetings providing support to social care with the educational element as required
- providing careers interviews to SEND pupils in year 9, 10 and 11 and as necessary, those aged 16-25 ahead of educational transition

The main responsibility and focus of the team

- offer adults, mental capacity, social care needs, and support assessments
- offer carers assessment
- provide long term Social Work intervention to support those eligible (under the Care Act 2004) to meet their identified outcomes

Roles and responsibilities within the team

- case management placement and residential reviews, conducting safeguarding and deprivation investigations and implementing risk management plans, contribute towards the social care element of an EHCP, promote independence choice and control
- health care complete Continuing Health Care (CHC) checklists, assessments and reviews, liaise with the Corporate Appointee team and learning disability nurses
